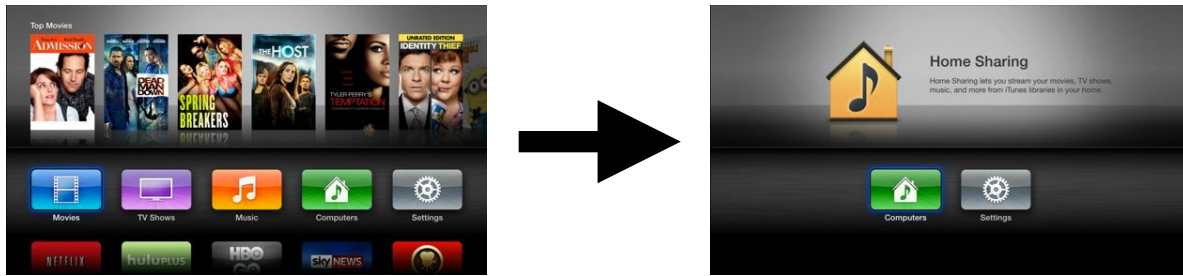


How to Configure Apple TV for the Classroom



Configuring Multiple Apple TVs Simultaneously

Connect one Apple TV to a projector or TV and then stack a group of other Apple TVs with power. We recommend a maximum of three stacks of five right next to each other. There should be no other Apple TVs being used in the same room during configuration to prevent issues.

Configuration Steps

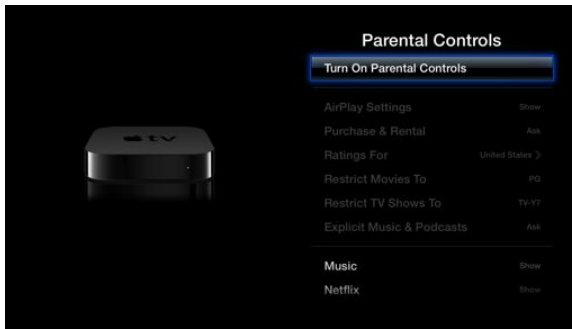
1. Complete the initial setup assistant by selecting a language, joining to Wi-Fi, and submitting diagnostic information



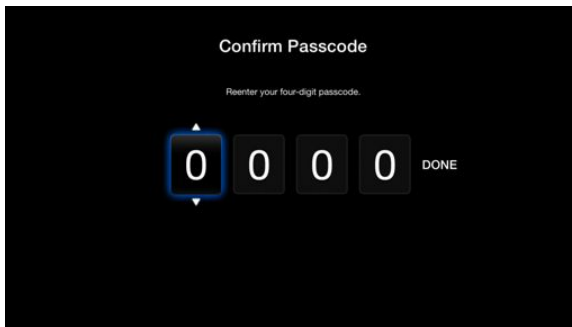
2. Open "Settings" then "General"



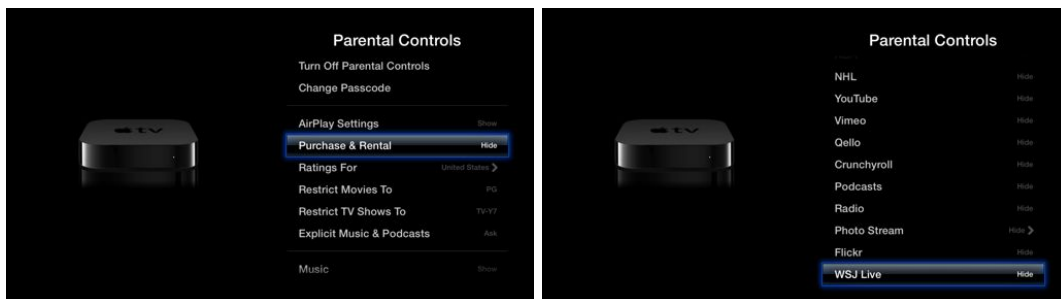
- To Remove the bricks on the main screen we need to select and turn on “Parental Controls”



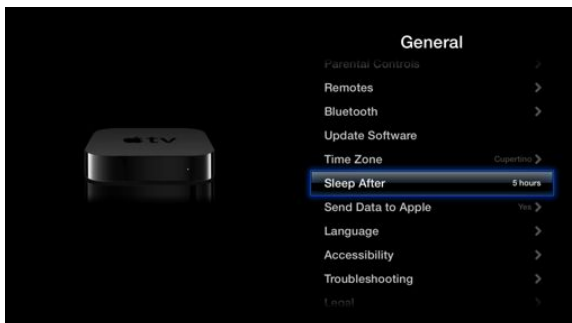
- Enter the same four digit passcode twice. We recommend “0000” since the purpose of the controls is to change the interface



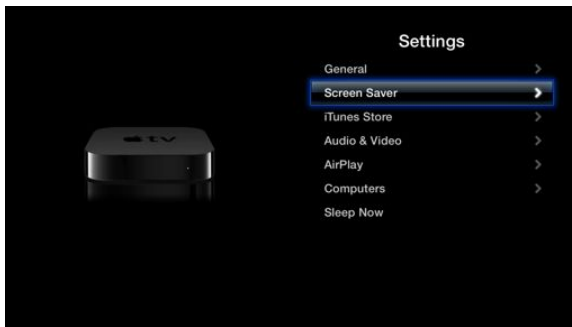
- Starting with “Purchase & Rental” set all options to “Hide.”



- Hit the Menu button once to get back to the General options
- Move down to “Sleep After” and set to “5 Hours”

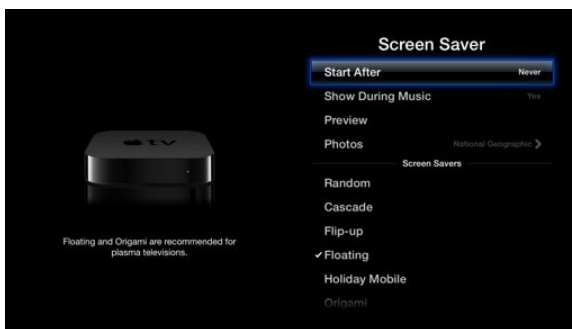


8. Hit the Menu button once to get back to the top level settings



9. Select "Screen Saver"

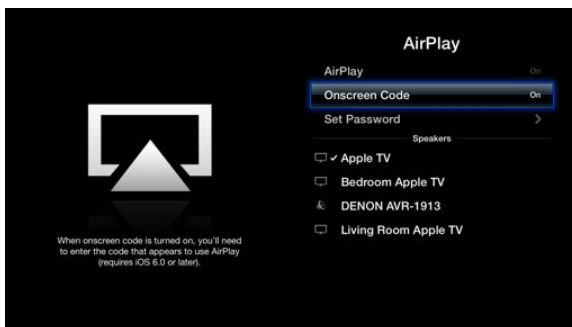
10. Set "Start After" to "Never"



11. Hit the Menu button once to get back to the top level settings

12. Select "AirPlay"

13. Turn "Onscreen Code" to On



14. If configuring multiple Apple TVs configure the device name one at a time by blocking the IR port or unplugging other Apple TVs

15. Under General select "Name" and customize the name to the device's location.
